



This Burgundian-style pinot noir comes from one of the most historic vineyards in California. Aromas are undeniably pinot noir with that telltale dark black cherry and a hint of licorice. On the palate, the wine is substantial and complex and of course, deliciously seductive as only a pinot noir can be. The winemaker painstakingly blended barrels, some of which added the silky fruit, while others contributed the complexity, backbone and earthiness that Bacigalupi gives.
