Our Sauvignon Blanc – named for the Canadian geese that winter nest each year near by the crush pad at our St. Helena Winery – is sourced from some of the best and well-known Napa Valley sites for growing this variety. The aromas carry the telltale signs of fresh mown herbs with lovely, creamy, bright fresh fruit such as pineapple, white nectarines, and guava. The wine lingers in the mouth for a long while, while balancing acidity cleanses the palate.
